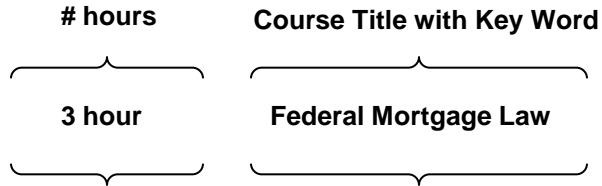


NMLS Course Naming Convention – Pre-Licensure Courses (PE) updated 12/29/2009

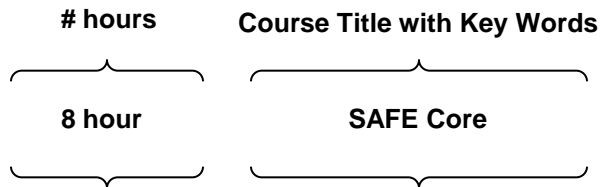
Single Course intended to satisfy a portion of the requirements, i.e. Federal Law:

Note: course length must be 3 hours for Federal law, 3 hours for ethics or 2 hours for nontraditional mortgage:



Bundle of Courses intended to satisfy the CORE portion of the requirements (Federal Law, Ethics, Nontraditional Mortgage)

Note: must contain 3 hrs of Federal law + 3 hours of ethics + 2 hours of nontraditional mortgage = 8 hours:



NMLS Course Naming Convention – Pre-Licensure Courses (PE) cont. updated 12/29/2009

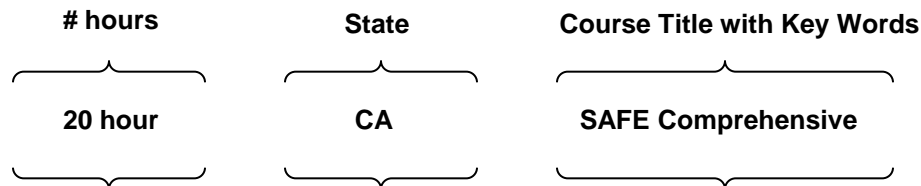
Course intended to satisfy all of the requirements associated with PE

Note: must contain 3 hrs of Federal law + 3 hours of ethics + 2 hours of nontraditional mortgage + 12 hours of undefined content (electives) = 20 hours:



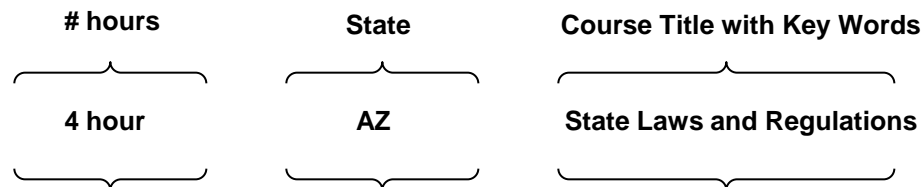
Course intended to satisfy all of the requirements associated with PE with State Requirements included

Note: must contain 3 hrs of Federal law + 3 hours of ethics + 2 hours of nontraditional mortgage + X hours of State specific content + remaining hours of undefined (electives) = 20 hours:



Course intended to satisfy a State PE Requirements

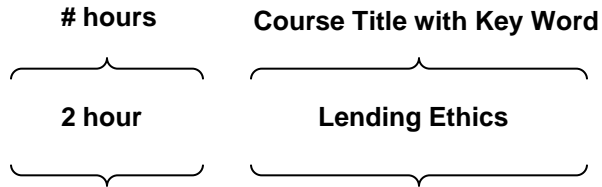
Note: must contain X required number of hours of state specified content. NOTE: when submitting course for approval, course needs to be registered under “PE Elective” since it is neither a Core or Comprehensive course.



NMLS Course Naming Convention – Continuing Education Courses (CE) updated 12/29/2009

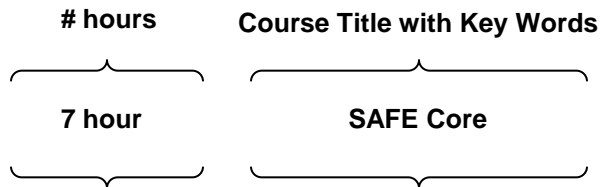
Single Course intended to satisfy a portion of the requirements, i.e. Federal Law:

Bundle of Courses intended to satisfy the CORE portion of the requirements (Federal Law, Ethics, Nontraditional Mortgage)

Note: must contain 3 hrs of Federal law + 2 hours of ethics + 2 hours of nontraditional mortgage = 7 hours:
