GENERAL INFORMATION

Who is required to complete the Uniform Authorized Agent Reporting (UAAR)?

Colorado Division of Banking (Division) Money Transmitter Licensees who hold an active license on NMLS with another state agency are required to report their authorized agents/delegate through the Uniform Authorized Agent Reporting (UAAR).

Division Money Transmitter Licensees not currently using NMLS for other state licensure should continue to report authorized agents/deletes directly to the Division as required under the Division quarterly Report of Condition and Income guidelines.

Upon license approval, applicants are required to utilize the UAAR to upload a list of agents who are authorized to conduct money transmission business in the state of Colorado on the Applicant's behalf. Agent adjustments (additions, deletions, and modifications) must be submitted through the UAAR on a quarterly basis, even if there are no changes to report. For more information, consult the NMLS Resource Center. Note: A licensee's branch locations should NOT be uploaded with the authorized agents/delegates.
