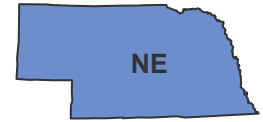




Surrender
Jurisdiction-Specific Requirements



NEBRASKA MORTGAGE LOAN ORIGINATOR LICENSE

Instructions

1. If the Mortgage Loan Originator does not intend to continue originating Nebraska loans, notification of license surrender must be filed in the NMLS.
2. There are no fees for surrender through NMLS.
3. The Mortgage Loan Originator licensee is the **only** party that can surrender a mortgage loan originator license. The removal of sponsorship only will place the mortgage loan originator license into an "Approved-Inactive" status. A mortgage loan originator **does not have the authority to originate under the "Approved-Inactive" license status**. A license can remain in an "Approved-Inactive" license status until a new Nebraska licensed sponsoring company is found. If you intend to find a new sponsoring company you may not wish to surrender. Once a license is surrendered, if the MLO decides to later return to originating Nebraska loans a new license application would need to be submitted to the Department.
4. Jurisdiction-specific requirements should be completed first as identified on the checklist below as they must be received with this checklist within 5 business days of the electronic submission of your filing through the NMLS at the following:
