



# Surrender Jurisdiction-Specific Requirements



## VERMONT COMMERCIAL LENDER LICENSE

### Instructions

1. Licensee must notify the Vermont Banking Division in writing 30 days prior to submitting a request to surrender this license authority through the NMLS.
2. Surrender of the Company Commercial Lender License for the main address requires the surrender of **all** Branch Commercial Lender Licenses issued by the Vermont Banking Division.
3. All original commercial lender license certificates for the current calendar year must be returned to the Vermont Banking Division, along with this checklist, within 5 business days of electronically submitting the surrender of the license(s) through the NMLS at the following:
