An Alaska mortgage loan originators' (MLO) license is issued for a calendar year and being quarantined for 14-30 days would not be considered the majority of their time over the course of a year under 3 AAC 14.415 or 3 AAC 14.515. A branch registration for the MLO's home would not be required for this short period of time. The company sponsoring the MLO should ensure they provide guidance to the MLO on how they will be supervised and ensure compliance with the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (GLBA).
