I understand that any false or fraudulent representation or substantial misrepresentation may be grounds for denial of any license application pending with the Division or revocation of any license granted by the Division, and could result in other legal action initiated against me, including but not limited to criminal prosecution.

I further acknowledge and confirm:

- The Applicant has not engaged in unlicensed activity <u>at any location</u> prior to the issuance of a license for that location by the Division.
- The Applicant has obtained surety bond coverage (if will be sponsored by an RMLA exempt entity that does not carry a bond) in the amount and in compliance with the Revised Code provisions pursuant to which the Applicant is seeking licensure (if applicable).
- The Applicant understands the ongoing duty to provide updated information to the Division regarding any material changes on the application.
- The ongoing duty of the Applicant to provide notice to the Division if the Applicant has been convicted or pled guilty or nolo contender to any felony or misdemeanor criminal offense in any domestic, foreign, or military court.
- The ongoing duty of the Applicant to provide notice to the Division if the Applicant is sanctioned by any government agency in conjunction with any financial matter, including personal or business-related judgments.
