How To

Add a Web Address:

- 1. From the Web Addresses screen, click Add.
- 2. Enter a Website Address.
- 3. Select the **radio button** to answer Yes or No, indicating if the company is accepting applications or transacting business through its website.
- 4. Click Save.

Helpful Hints

- Callers have frequently asked what the definition of "transacting business" is. Users are encouraged to contact their state regulator to ensure they are answering the question in accordance with regulator guidelines.
- 2. States may have additional requirements for websites, check state licensing requirements for additional information.
