## **Policy**

A federal criminal background check (CBC) can be authorized through the Individual Form (MU4) for individuals seeking licensure as well as through the Individual Form (MU2) for an individual in a position of control for a company or branch.

If permitted by applicable state law, state agencies have the ability to allow or require the following MU2 individuals to authorize and pay for a CBC through NMLS:

- Direct Owners/Executive Officers (DO/EO)
- Indirect Owners (IO)
- Qualifying Individuals (QI)
- Branch Managers

Review the <u>MU2 CBC Requirements Chart</u> on the NMLS Resource Center to determine CBC MU2 requirements. CBC for MU2 requirements can also be found on the applicable <u>state licensing checklists</u> also found on the NMLS Resource Center.




Figure 1: Criminal Background Check
